West Atlantic announces change of CEO.

The Board of West Atlantic has, in unison with its CEO, decided to make a change to the top position of the company. Mr. Lars Jordahn will step down effective immediately from the position of CEO.

During the past five years, under Lars Jordahn's leadership, the company has experienced significant transformations, including changes in ownership with the acquisition by the Lusat-Swiftair group. Additionally, West Atlantic has undergone major fleet and organizational changes during a period with BREXIT and the influence of the Pandemic. The Company is now entering a new phase where both West Atlantic Sweden and West Atlantic UK will act directly as independent airlines in the wider Swiftair group.

Mr. Salvador Moreno, Chairman of the Board, added: "The decision for a change of chief executive has been mutual and the board wishes to extend its gratitude to Mr. Jordahn for his valuable contribution to the Group during his five years in office." Mr. Jordahn will remain attached to the Company in an advisory role during the period of transition.
